“GOD CO-LABORS WITH MEN OF FAITH”

VIII. Lilian B. Yeomans said it this way: *“God has tied himself irrevocably to human cooperation in the execution of divine purposes. He has made man’s faith a determining factor in the work of redemption.”*

A. This helps us to understand Hebrews 11:1; **“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”**

1. The Amplified Bible says, **“Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title-deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality – faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses.”**
2. What is faith and how does it work?
 - a. Faith is the substance – the substance that everything is made of is faith.
 - b. Substance means that which has mass and occupies space; matter.
 - c. Or we could say it this way, faith is the substance of “matter”, and all matter is brought into existence through the Spirit of Faith.
 - d. God make it clear that as believers we must use the Spirit of Faith in order to enact faith for what we desire.
 - e. What is the Spirit of Faith and how do we enact it? **“We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak.”** (2 Corinthians 4:13)
3. The word “substance” in the King James translation does not convey the full meaning of faith with the word “substance”.

- a. The Amplified version says that faith is our assurance which means that it is our *confirmation and title deed to our desire*.
- b. In order for faith to be the assurance or confirmation and title deed to our desire there are three things that must follow.
 - (1) Faith must become the proof of things that (we) hope for....
 - (2) The proof of things we do not see.....
 - (3) The conviction of their reality.....which is faith perceiving as real Heaven’s reality over earth’s reality (the senses).
4. My translation would be, **“Now faith is the turning of dreams (desires) into deeds; it is betting your life on unseen realities.**
5. Faith always comes with sound, voice, and smell through words.
 - a. The visible was made from the invisible.
 - b. Things that are seen are not made of things that can be seen.
 - c. The unseen is more powerful than the seen.
 - d. This is why we walk by faith and not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).
6. Hiding in the *quarks* is the sound of faith (vibrations) that frames our world.
 - a. Words of faith contain the building blocks of all matter in which the will of God spoke in our behalf (His Word).
 - b. Words of faith are released by the Spirit of Faith (**I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak**”) which is law of allowing.
7. When we release the Word of God in faith it is more than our voice that is speaking.
 - a. This is revealed clearly in Matthew 10:20 AMP: **“For it is not you who are speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you.”**
 - b. The Spirit is powerful as revealed in Acts 14:3 AMP: **“.....speaking freely and fearlessly and boldly in the Lord, Who continued to bear testimony to the Word of His grace, granting signs and**
