2. Did you hear that? God has given many promises to us and we can find our yes answer to all of them in Christ.
3. Then in verse 21 we find that God is able to back up His promises to us, **“But it is God Who confirms and makes us steadfast and *establishes* us [in joint fellowship] with you in Christ...”**.
 - a. The word “*establish*” here means to bring about; generate.
4. So, in verse 21 we understand that God backs up His promises by establishing “*the desires of our heart.*”
5. This means God brings about His promises by “*generating*” His energy toward our desires.
6. And He does this through vibrational agreement, and this vibrational agreement between God and us must always be in accordance with His Word.
 - a. I can hear some of you now, generating, generating what?
 - b. The answer lies in understanding the laws of energy which are now revealed by quantum physics – namely that all that exists in the universe is Energy.
7. There is One Power (God) and everything that exists generates out of Him in order that we may be established.
 - a. The science of quantum physics calls this One Power of energy “*the unified field of energy*”.
 - b. It is difficult for our finite (having bounds, limited) minds to understand the infinite (in’-fi-nit) (having no boundaries or limits), but we can learn to understand God’s mind by learning His laws by which He governs the universe.
 - c. These laws are the laws of energy, and energy is equal to desire and purpose.

- IV. What is there about the human voice that is so important?
- A. Why did Jesus say, “...**he shall have whatsoever he saith**”?
1. First of all there is no other voice like your voice. Your voice is your address in the realm of the spirit.
 - a. Scientists tell us that the voice print is just as accurate in determining an individual’s identity as his fingerprint.
 - b. There is no other voice like your voice.
 2. The psalmist David said, “**In my distress I called upon the Lord, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into his ears. Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of the hills moved...**” (Psalm 18:6-7).
 3. The truth is, your voice is made up of vibrational sound, and it does not take long for it to reach the Source of all energy, God.
 - a. God responds to your voice. In fact, your voice moves heaven, and if it can move heaven then it certainly can move mountains and trees on this earth.
 4. Your voice is the way to have a change of scenery in your life.
 - a. You must lift up your voice with the voice of faith that believes, expects, and will not be denied.
 5. Not only does God respond to the voice of faith, but angels are also activated by your words which are vibrations of sound.
 - a. An angel told Daniel, “...**thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words**” (Daniel 10:12).
 - b. Daniel’s spoke the word of faith and an angel came to the right address. How?
 - c. Through Daniel’s words which are vibrations of sound in harmony with God.
 6. Ruth Heflin tells in her book “Glory” that the word “*ladder*” in the Old Testament , has the same numerical value as the word “*voice*” in the

New Testament.

- a. This “*ladder*” in the Old Testament was the one Jacob saw angels ascending and descending (Genesis 28:12).
- b. All of this seems to indicate that it may be that angels travel on your “*voice ladder*” .
- c. Your voice could well be the vibrational road that angels travel on to bring things to you from heaven.
- d. This angel traffic could very well be blocked if your vibrational road was not aligned with the Source (God).

- V. A leading neurosurgeon recently made the statement that the speech center in the human brain exercises dominion over the whole central nervous system.
- A. He continued in the article to say that this recent discovery by science found that when the speech center of the brain is stimulated, the whole central nervous system responds.
