- our armchairs.
- a. But we are shifting from a purely Newtonian way of engineering and solving problems believing that everything is separate and we must work toward our goal.
 - b. We are compelled to shift to a quantum way of thinking, where we strongly and clearly identify with the outcome.
3. This quantum way of thinking is important because it opens the doorway from the physical world and causes it to respond to a *new reality*.
 4. There is a powerful video documentation of just how quickly this can happen.
 - a. In this video we see a woman who is diagnosed with an inoperable, cancerous tumor, in the presence of three practitioners who are trained in this language we’re talking about.
 - b. Through ultrasound, you see that tumor melt away and literally vanish from the screen.
 5. This new quantum way introduces thought empowered with feelings – such powerful feelings that the tumor responds and dissipates in less than three minutes.
 - a. By the way, this is not a one-time phenomenon; they do this for brain and bladder tumors all the time in this part of China.
 - b. The same principle applies when numbers of people get together to feel peace in a broad geographic region, or to feel the successful outcome of their project in a business.

“THE QUANTUM POWER OF LIVING FROM THE ANSWER”

“CHRISTIANITY IS A HEART BASED RELIGION”

- X. Religious people can have all the hell fire and brimstone they want, I’m into the Abba Father that Jesus saw, the God that Jesus talked with daily.
 - A. Transformation will continue to be a distant hope until the church stops making religion a matter of the head and not of the heart.

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1. As a result we have 30,000 Christian denominations in the world alone.
 2. We need more heart based beliefs than head bound ones; however, making that twelve inch transfer from the head to the heart is not an easy adventure.
 3. Greg Braden, in his new book, “The Spontaneous Healing Of Belief” nailed it.
 - a. Concerning true transformation he wrote, ***“Scientific evidence reveals that heart-based belief affect everything from the healing of our bodies to the atoms of the world. Is it possible that we’re born to reverse disease, create peace and abundance, and even change reality itself? As we face the greatest challenges of human history, these new discoveries suggest that we’re about to find out.”***
 4. Jesus brought the message of the HEART and not the HEAD.
 - a. We’re still missing the good news. We are still uncomfortable with GRACE!
 - b. Yet I know, heart healing will one day prevail.
- B. We now know through science that the world is made of electromagnetic fields of information, and this field is THE MATRIX OF ALL MATTER – THE MIND OF GOD.
1. If you want to change something in the world, you’ve got to communicate within that electromagnetic field.
 2. Science has now found – and it has been published in peer-reviewed journals over the last few years – that the human heart is the largest generator of electrical and magnetic fields in the body, and it has the power to communicate within the field.
 3. It has been found that our brains generate an electrical and a magnetic field, but they’re relatively weak, as compared to the heart.
 4. The electrical field of the heart is about 100 times stronger than that of the brain, and the heart’s magnetic field is about 5,000 times stronger than the magnetic field of the brain.

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5. Our own physics textbooks say that if you want to change the atoms of physical matter, you have to change either the electrical field or the magnetic field; the heart does both.
6. From this study you have been taught the importance of proper thinking, but you also have been shown that feelings in some ways are more effective than thinking.
7. In our western society we have been conditioned to believe that feelings and emotions are ineffective.
 - a. In fact we are taught as men not to have them.
 - b. Women have been told, “If you’re going to have them, go have them somewhere else, where it won’t bother anyone!”
 - c. But outside our society you will find it quite the opposite. In the monasteries in Tibet, for example, they say that feeling is the most powerful force in the universe.
 - d. At one monastery, Greg Braden asked the abbot, “In your tradition, what is the force that connects everything in the universe?”
 - e. He answered Braden with a single word, and that word was “Compassion.”
8. What do we need to do? We need to discard false assumptions and realize that space is not empty, and that our interior world can have tremendous impact on the external world.
 - a. May God help us to see that everything is connected to everything else, and we can not longer think of ourselves ONLY when we make decisions, whether in the context of our family, our community or the world.

“REWRITING THE REALITY CODE”

C. The 13th Century mystic Rumi, stated, ***“What strange beings we are! That sitting in Hell at the bottom of the dark, we are afraid of our own immortality!”***

1. Perhaps it is actually the power to choose our immortality, as well as

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- everything from our personal healing to the peace of our world, that truly frightens us!
2. Many scientist today believe that it *our consciousness* that holds the key to life and even reality itself!
 3. In 1967 the pioneering physicist Konrad Zuse married the ideas of consciousness with modern technology and proposed that our universe works like a massive consciousness computer.
 - a. And just as every computer translates “Input commands into “Output -results,” our cosmic consciousness computer appears to do precisely the same thing!
 - b. When we translate our deepest beliefs into the reality of our world, we are literally re-writing the code that makes the universe appear as it does.

“LIVING IN A PARTICIPATORY UNIVERSE”

- D. A series of breathtaking discoveries has given us a powerful new way to think of our role in the universe.
1. Rather than the conventional view that suggests we are passive observers, living a brief moment of time in a creation that already exists, the discoveries suggest that it is actually *consciousness itself* that is responsible for the existence of the universe!
 2. There are some revolutionary scientific studies that support this idea.
 - a. When we look at the stuff our world is made of – tiny quantum particles such as an electron, for example – the very act of us watching that electron changes the way it behaves in our presence.
 - b. What’s more, the longer we look, the more it changes!
 - c. In 1998 scientists at Israel’s Weizmann Institute of Science documented this phenomenon showing that “the greater the amount of ‘watching,’ the greater the observer’s influence on what actually takes place.”
 3. Princeton University physicist John Wheeler suggest that we not only

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play a role in the creation of our everyday world, but we play the prime role in what he calls a participatory universe.

- a. Wheeler states that we can no longer think of ourselves merely as onlookers who have no effect on the world around us, because it is impossible to simply watch.
- b. If we are alive and conscious, then we are affecting our world.
- c. “The old word ‘observer,’ he says, “simply has to be crossed off the books...and we must put in the new word participator!”

“THE ART OF MANIFESTATION”

- E. All matter in the physical universe is a manifestation of the mind.
 1. Manifestation in the psychic realm is a product of our mind conjoined with the Mind of God.
 2. Our job is to learn how to tap into the tremendous resource that is within and around us.
 3. God has designed His creation to give us everything we want, but we must be careful how we design our order.
 4. The law of affinity guarantees that we will attract to us what we store in our minds.
 - a. If we want poverty, sickness, or unhappiness, all we need is to focus on these conditions, and we will attract them into our lives.
 - b. We in fact create these conditions with our thoughts, emotions and feelings.
 5. People who are motivated by fear (there are a lot of them) view the world upside down.
 - a. Fear causes limitation and uncertainty, and leads to all sorts of negative situations.
 - b. When we are fearful, we feel separated and isolated from the world.
 - c. This diminishes our power.
 6. We must stop looking at the world from a “poverty” consciousness.
 - a. We are the only ones who can turn away the abundance that life has
