### **“WE MUST FOLLOW JESUS IN HIS PRIMARY MISSION”**

II. So what is the primary mission?

- A. We saw it in the life of Jesus on this earth and we find it in the “testimony” of Scripture in 1John 3:8: **“The one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, that He might destroy the works of the devil.”**
  1. Jesus had an assignment, and it was to **“...destroy the works of the devil.”**
  2. Only this would allow Jesus to be able to expand the Kingdom of Heaven on this earth.
  3. I submit this statement to you: “It was Adam and Eve’s assignment to expand the kingdom; it was the disciples’ assignment, and it’s our assignment today, nothing has changed.
  4. To the Christian today, God has commissioned them to demonstrate the will of God, “on earth as it is in heaven.”
    - a. There is only one way to carry our co-mission out, and that is for us to accept sub-mission to the primary mission. Which is!
    - b. The ***expanding of the Kingdom of Heaven on this earth*** by enforcing Jesus’ rule of authority in destroying the works of the devil.
  5. The result is the transforming of this planet into a place radiant with His glory and covered with the presence of His power.
  6. The above view is not accepted today by most Christians, but I believe it is the very backbone of the Great Commission.

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a. And if I am correct, it should define the believer's life as Christians.

**“OUR PRIMARY MISSION MUST REACH THOSE AROUND US”**

B. It is my firm belief that the Church should be training disciples to minister signs and wonders as the will of God to people everywhere.

1. This training should especially be keen to teach these disciples how to operate in the supernatural (spiritual) outside the four walls of the church.
2. When we do the will of God, we bring Kingdom reality crashing into the works of the devil. How does this work?
  - a. We initiate conflict between earthly reality and heavenly reality.
  - b. The moment the conflict is enacted we become the bridge and connection with Heaven and the point of contact that makes this type of ministry possible.
- c. It is only through our prayer and radical obedience that we can assert the rulership of God.
3. Let me ask you a pointed question; aren't you tired of talking about a gospel of power, but never seeing it in action?
  - a. Aren't you tired of trying to carry out the Great Commission without offering proof that the Kingdom works?
  - b. When we tell people that we represent the King and His Kingdom, but fail to act on its message, we are improperly representing Jesus and His message.
4. Have we not missed the bulk of what Jesus taught?
5. In the great commission Jesus said, **“These signs shall accompany them that believe: in my name shall they cast out demons; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall in no wise hurt them; they shall lay hands on the**
